**Return to Worship Guidelines**

**Regina, Saskatchewan**

**Psalm 122:1**

*I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.*

Recognizing the need for caution and for awareness of Saskatchewan Government Guidelines, the Elders of Bethany Gospel Chapel set forth the following guidelines for worship.

People who are medically vulnerable should not attend, nor should people who are not feeling well.

Members are asked to register weekly when they intend to attend Lord's Day services and will be assigned seats. Families will be assigned seating together.

Worshippers are asked to wear masks as they enter and as they leave the building.

Limited singing will be done, generally 2 to 3 songs per meeting. People should remain seated and are encouraged to wear a mask when singing. The worship leader should be at a distance so that he will not need a mask when singing.

When you enter the Chapel, you will see a hand sanitizer station and we ask that you use the sanitizer as you enter and as you leave. Hand sanitizer will also be placed near the washrooms.

Fellowship cups for communion will be set out on a table. Those who intend to participate in the breaking of bread are asked to take a cup with them to their seat.

A basket or box for offerings will be on the table as well.

There will be a brief break between Breaking of Bread and the teaching portion of the service. At that time, used fellowship cups should be discarded.
